Notice of Petition for Annexation

A petition for annexation (the Rushton-Squires Addition to the Town of New Harmony) has been filed with the Town of New Harmony, Utah, proposing the annexation of an area to the town. The complete annexation petition is available for inspection and copying at the office of the New Harmony Town Clerk. The area proposed for annexation is described as follows:

Commencing at the South 1/4 Corner of Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 13 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Thence North 00°21'12" West, along the Center Section line a distance of 1884.10 feet to the Point of Beginning, said point being on the Easterly line of the Frehner Addition Annexation to New Harmony Town as shown by Document #20070058606, Official Washington County Records; Thence North 00°21'12" West, along said line, a distance of 771.19 feet to the Center 1/4 Corner of said Section 22; Thence South 89°51'16" East, along the East -West Center Section line, a distance of 661.67 feet, to a point on the Westerly line of that parcel shown by Tax ID #3070-A-1-B-1-NS, Washington County Records; Thence South 00°02'08" West, along said line, a distance of 769.47 feet; Thence South 89°59'51" West along the South line of that Parcel shown by Tax ID #3070-J-NS Washington County Records, a distance of 656.43 feet, to the Point of Beginning. Rushton-Squires Annexation Addition Contains: 11.65 acres On April 28, 2022, in accordance with Utah Code Ann. §10-2-405(2)(c)(i), the New Harmony Town Council received Notice of Certification that the petition meets all requirements of Utah Code Ann. §10-2-403. The Town of New Harmony may grant the petition and annex the area described in the petition unless a written protest to the annexation petition is filed on or before May 31, 2022, 2021 with the Washington County Boundary Commission, located at 197 E. Tabernacle Street, St. George, Utah, 84770, and a copy of the protest delivered to the New Harmony Town Clerk.

The area proposed for annexation to The Town of New Harmony will also automatically be annexed to a local district providing fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services or a local district providing law enforcement service, as the case may be, as provided in Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-416, if: (a) the Town of New Harmony is entirely within the boundaries of a

local district that provides fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services or law enforcement service, respectively, and in the creation of which an election was not required because of Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-214(3)(c), and (b) the area proposed to be annexed to the Town of New Harmony is not already within the boundaries of the local district.

The area proposed for annexation to the Town of New Harmony will be automatically withdrawn from a local district providing fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services or a local district providing law enforcement service, as the case may be, as provided in §17B-1-502(2), if: (a) the petition proposes the annexation of an area that is within the boundaries of a local district that provides fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services or law enforcement service, respectively, and in the creation of which an election was not required because of Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-214(3)(c); and (b) the Town of New Harmony is not within the boundaries of the local district.
